## Towards a Green and Low-Carbon Economy: Signing of a Framework Partnership Agreement Between the Ministry of Energy Transition and Sustainable Development (MTEDD) and the Caisse de Dépôt et de Gestion (CDG)



As part of the Royal High Directives promoting the integration of sustainable development principles across all public policies and economic sectors of the Kingdom, Ms. Leila Benali, Minister of Energy Transition and Sustainable Development, and Mr. Khalid Safir, Director General of the Caisse de Dépôt et de Gestion, signed a framework partnership agreement on Tuesday, October 1, 2024. This agreement aims to accelerate the transition to a green and low-carbon economy. This agreement, which is part of a national initiative supporting strategic projects for sustainable development, outlines the collaboration between the CDG and MTEDD to facilitate the implementation of key initiatives and strategic projects in renewable energy, energy efficiency, ecological infrastructure, and green innovation. The key areas of partnership include:

- Contributing to the deployment of the National Sustainable Development Strategy;
- Promoting public administration as a model for sustainable development;
- Participating in the implementation of projects related to the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC);
- Supporting Territorial Climate Plans and promoting energy efficiency, particularly in public lighting, buildings, mobility, and waste management;
- Financing and structuring renewable energy projects, particularly in the fields of green hydrogen and electricity transmission;
- Supporting the creation of industrial ecosystems and mechanisms for research and innovation in sectors related to the energy transition.
